A Report

A two-day International Conference on “Innovation & Emerging Trends in Education,” was organised by Ghulam Ahmed College of Education (GACE), Banjara Hills, on 24th & 25th April, 2026.

The Two-Day International Conference brought together enthusiastic academicians, researchers, and students from various disciplines. Focusing on National Education Policy 2020, Sustainable Development Goals, Socio-Emotional Learning, Artificial Intelligence in Education and Educational Leadership, which fostered intellectual collaboration and academic exchange amongst the participants. The conference received an overwhelming response, with **200 participants** registering and actively taking part in the academic deliberations, paper presentations, and technical sessions.

A REPORT OF THE 2-DAY CONFERENCE:

Day 1: The Inaugural Session started with a Welcome Address by Prof. Vibha Asthana, Director, Ghulam Ahmed College of Education (GACE). The scope of the Conference was presented by Dr. Hureen Wasifa Siddiqui, Conference Coordinator, GACE; this was followed by the address by the Guest of Honour: Dr. Kim R. 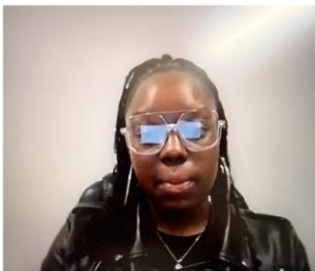


