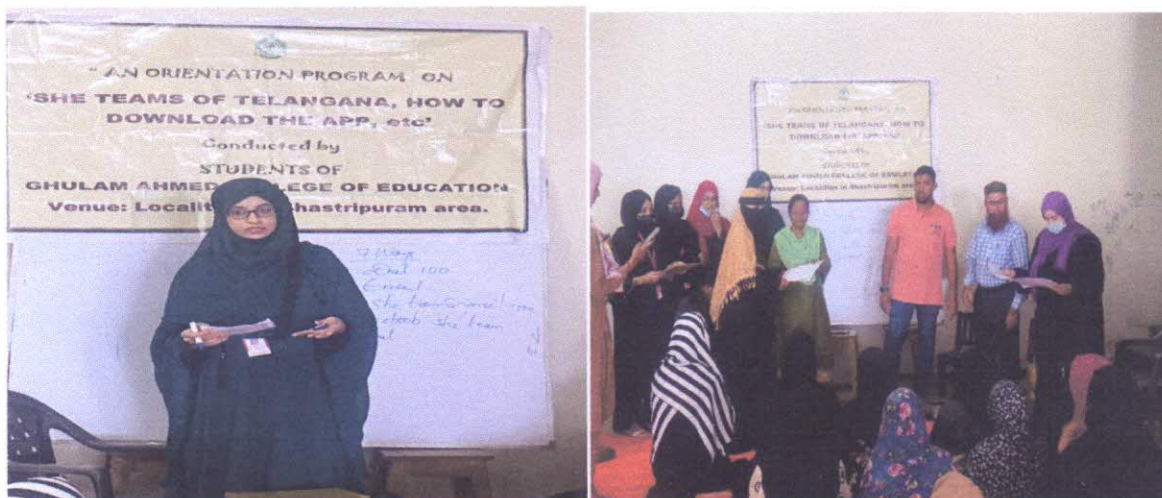
5. "She Teams" of Telangana – Guidance on how to Download App.

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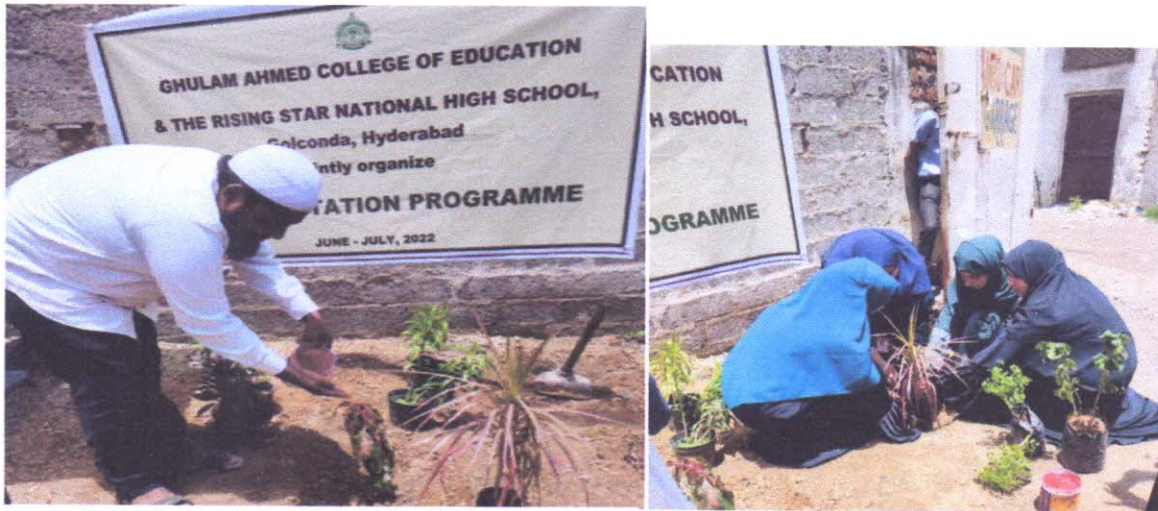
6. Tree plantation program

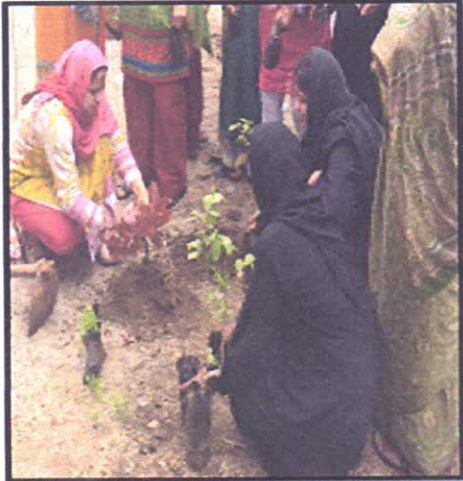
2. Tree plantation

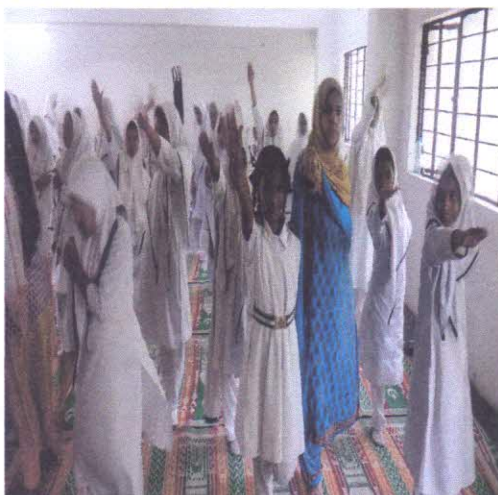
5. Importance of Physical exercise: Orienting the school children.
